Name of Field Trip:	<b>Cache Creek Gold Panning</b>
Location:	Cache Creek, Granite, CO
Limitation on Number of Participants or Other Issues:	The area will allow a maximum of about 7 vehicles. If the road is wet or muddy an all wheel drive or 4X4 will be needed. We will be carpooling from the Arkansas River Rim RV Park 12 miles to the site.
Brief Description of Field Trip:	We will be meeting at the Arkansas River Rim RV Park at 8:00 AM and leaving at 8:20 both Friday and Saturday for the site. We will be camping at the park and club members are encouraged to camp as well. The park is located 4.5 miles north of Buena Vista on Hwy 24 at mile marker 206. From the park we will carpool to the site 12 miles away. There are no facilities at the site and limited parking. Bring lunch, water, shovel, buckets and what you will be using to pan for gold. <b>YOU WILL ALSO NEED A SMALL VILE TO KEEP YOUR GOLD IN.</b> Groups are free to leave the site at any time and we will be packing it in about 3:00 each day. We will also be panning for Gold at the RV park as it has yielded many good panning experiences for us and many others. Jeff the owner caters to gold panners and has a very nice park.
Are there any Special Costs such as Admission Charge or Charge for Transportation on a Bus:	The only costs are if you wish to camp at the park and your transportation.
Collectible Materials, if any: <b>NOTE: SPECIFY IF COLLECTING CANNOT BE DONE</b>	This is GOLD. You can keep what you find.
Date of Trip:	Friday, July 18 and Saturday, July 19, 2008
Meeting Place:	We will be meeting at the Arkansas River Rim RV Park at 8:00 AM and leaving at 8:20 both Friday and Saturday for the site. We will be camping at the park and club members are encouraged to camp as well. The park is located 4.5 miles north of Buena Vista on Hwy 24 at mile marker 206. From the park we will carpool to the site 12 miles away. There are no facilities at the site and limited parking.
Time to Meet:	8:00 AM
Est. Time of Return to Original Meeting Place:	4:00 PM
Vehicle Requirements . If any:	We will need to carpool due to parking. Those driving to the site should have 4X4's that can hold buckets & shovels.
Physical Limitation Concerns, Including Accessibility to Handicapped Individuals:	There is no handicapped access to the area. Hiking is only for a very limited distance, but there is a lot of digging and hauling of dirt from the bank where the gold is down to the creek.
Equipment or Tools Recommended or Required:	Participants will need to bring 5 gallon bucket or buckets, a shovel and something to pan with. <b>YOU WILL ALSO NEED A SMALL VILE TO KEEP YOUR GOLD IN. Don't forget your sunscreen and hat.</b>
Availability of Water and Sanitary Facilities:	There is no potable water or sanitary facilities at the site. Please come prepared.
Additional Comments:	If you like to pan or want to have a great first time experience and find gold your first time out, this is a great trip.
