Location:	CSMS Claim near Lake George, Colorado.
Limitation on Number of Participants or Other Issues:	Limited to 12 vehicles due to the length of time to convoy in to the claims. And to CSMS Members. Please carpool to allow more members to participate. About 10 miles from Forest Station on dirt roads.
Brief Description of Field Trip:	This trip is for collecting in the Pikes Peak pegmatites at two private claims. Stay on trails. No ATV's.
Are there any Special Costs such as Admission Charge or Charge for Transportation on a Bus:	None.
Collectible Materials, if any: <b>NOTE: SPECIFY IF COLLECTING CANNOT BE DONE</b>	Smoky quartz, amazonite (if you are lucky), feldspar and other pegmatite minerals common to the area.
Date of Trip:	Saturday, July 19, 2008
Meeting Place:	Meet at Lake George Ranger Station on Trail Creek Road in Lake George. Approximately 38 miles from Colorado Springs, not later than 9:00 AM.
Time to Meet:	9:00 AM <b>NO LATER!</b>
Est. Time of Return to Original Meeting Place:	Vehicles can leave at their choice of time, but no later than 4:00 PM.
Vehicle Requirements . If any:	Four wheel drive with low range required.
Physical Limitation Concerns, Including Accessibility to Handicapped Individuals:	The trip it is at a higher altitude than Colorado Springs (approx. 8,000 - 8,500 feet) so those who have a difficulty with altitude should not participate. Not recommended for those who have difficulty in walking on uneven terrain.
Equipment or Tools Recommended or Required:	A small pick and shovel, an old paint brush, an old screw driver, a rock hammer, safety glasses, and some sort of bucket or pack for carrying any specimens found. Also desirable are some paper for wrapping specimens.
Availability of Water and Sanitary Facilities:	There are no facilities available. Bring water, snack and a lunch.
Additional Comments:	The weather can change between morning and afternoon at this altitude and this time of the year. Wear appropriate clothing (layered) and hiking boots. Sunscreen is recommended. <b>It is important that you arrive on time and you follow the schedule. Contact Ray Berry by phone or e-mail to reserve a spot for this Field Trip.</b>
