Collectible Materials, if any: NOTE: SPECIFY IF COLLECTING CANNOT BE DONE	Smoky Quartz, Quartz, and Amethyst in a chevroned formation. This is massive material and not individual crystals. The material is good for tumbling.

Meeting Place:	The north side of the Burger King parking lot in Canon City. The Burger King is just off US-50 on the north side of the road (going west) before you get into the heart of Canon City. If you get to the Depot Museum you've gone too far.
