Name of Field Trip:	<b>PERIDOT CLAIM STAKING - A WORKING FIELD TRIP</b>
Location:	Southern Park County, Colorado
Limitation on Number of Participants or Other Issues:	This is a working Filed Trip. All participants should be CSMS members and should be willing to assist in the staking of the 4 Peridot Claims.
Brief Description of Field Trip:	The primary purpose of the trip will be to place 9 corner stakes and 4 Points of Discovery stakes on the four Peridot Claims which CSMS has secured. After that is done members are encouraged to take time to collect Peridot Crystals
Are there any Special Costs such as Admission Charge or Charge for Transportation on a Bus:	None but some of you may wish to carpool.
Collectible Materials, if any: <b>NOTE: SPECIFY IF COLLECTING CANNOT BE DONE</b>	Peridot Crystals Collecting will take place after the stakes are in place.
Date of Trip:	Saturday, September 06, 2008
Meeting Place:	Bayou Salado Trading Post, Hartsel, CO---where they have excellent coffee and ice cream! West end of Hartsel on the right.
Time to Meet:	9:30 AM
Est. Time of Return to Original Meeting Place:	3:30 PM
Vehicle Requirements, if any:	High clearance 4 wheel drive is required to cross Badger Creek in order to get to our Claims.
Physical Limitation Concerns, Including Accessibility to Handicapped Individuals:	The Claims are at above 9,000 foot elevation and on a slope. Participants will be expected to carry the stakes (4ft 4x4's), sledge hammers, electric drills and metal stakes across rough terrain over an 80 acre area.
Equipment or Tools Recommended or Required:	For the staking we will need members with a GPS unit, battery operated electric drill/screw driver, and a four pound sledge hammer (or greater if desires). For collecting you will need tweezers, a small container (prescription or film container), knee pads, sunscreen, food and lots of water. For those of you who want to use screens a half inch and quarter inch screen is recommended. Yam will bring the stakes, the metal stakes to be driven into the ground, screws and stake location information.
Availability of Water and Sanitary Facilities:	None. Bring water and food.
Additional Comments:	Additional Field Trips will be setup after the Claims have been staked. This is a working trip and all volunteers will be greatly appreciated. <b>Please call or e-mail Yam if you plan to participate.</b> <b>Special thanks to CSMS member Kerry Burroughs for determining all of the GPS coordinates for this effort.</b>
