Limitation on Number of Participants or Other Issues:	A minimum of five participants must be signed up by May 1st or this Filed Trip may be cancelled. Rainy weather may preclude the field portion of this Field Trip.
Brief Description of Field Trip:	This Field Trip offers two opportunities to have fun. Attendance at the Grand Junction Mineral Show on Saturday May 8th, and then leave on May 8th (when you are done with the Show) to do collecting in Utah of pseudo morphs/barite and black and white petrified wood. Collecting will be done on Sunday unless the weather and conditions are not favorable. Marg will hand out maps to the camping site (in Utah) at the 8:30 AM meeting. She is planning on staying a few extra days to further explore the area, so others are invited to stay on.
Are there any Special Costs such as Admission Charge or Charge for Transportation on a Bus:	None at this time. If you car pool with someone you may want to contribute to the cost of their gas. Lodging in Grand Junction or camping fees may be necessary.

Est. Time of Return to Original Meeting Place:	N/A Those participating in this FT are free to leave whenever they desire. Please advise Marg of your departure.
Vehicle Requirements, if any:	A regular vehicle will suffice.
Physical Limitation Concerns, Including Accessibility to Handicapped Individuals:	None of any significance.
Equipment or Tools Recommended or Required:	Usual collecting equipment. Most material can be readily picked up off of the ground. Camping equipment if you plan on camping with Marg.
Availability of Water and Sanitary Facilities:	Yes, in Grand Junction but not available in the field. Bring water, food and clothing for changeable weather. Make sure you have a full tank of gas before you leave Grand Junction. There is none out there.
Additional Comments:	Marg may stay additional days in the area to do additional collecting. Discuss this with her directly. Be sure to get gas and whatever else you need in Grand Junction before you leave. There is nothing in the area of the collecting site. Also Cell phone service is questionable at best. <b>Make sure you call or e-mail Marg before April 28th with your name and phone numbers (cell and home) so she can call you if the trip needs to be cancelled for any reason.</b>
