

<b>Name of Field Trip:</b>	<b>Gold Camp Road (St. Peter's Dome Area)</b>
<b>Date of Trip:</b>	Saturday, June 05, 2010
<b>Meeting Place:</b>	Cheyenne Plaza Shopping Center - From I-25, take the South Nevada and Tejon St. exit and proceed south to Cheyenne Road (this intersection is Cheyenne Road on the west and Southgate Road on the east.) Turn west on Cheyenne Road. Proceed to the second traffic light which is 8th Street. Turn right (north) on 8th Street. Go north one block and pass Cheyenne Blvd. (Cheyenne Road and Cheyenne Blvd. run parallel.) Proceed north on 8th St. The Cheyenne Plaza Shopping Center is on the right. Steve will be driving a dark gray Nissan pickup with a white topper.

<b>Location of Field Trip:</b>	Southwest of Colorado Springs in the shadow of Pikes Peak along a section of Gold Camp Road normally closed to vehicles. St. Peter's Dome and Stove Mountain areas.
<b>Limitation on Number of Participants or Other Issues:</b>	None. It is recommended that people car pool to limit the number of vehicles in the convoy. This will make parking along Gold Camp Road easier. This trip is open to other club members and should be advertised as open to all clubs in the area.
<b>Brief Description of Field Trip:</b>	Once we enter the Gold Camp Road closure gate, everyone will be locked in and no one can leave until 4:30 PM sharp. This trip will not go to the Eureka Tunnel, but the day will be spent at a location where collecting is both above and below the road.
<b>Are there any Special Costs such as Admission Charge or Charge for Transportation on a Bus:</b>	This trip depends on continued access permission from the Forest Service granted to the Trip Leader.
<b>Collectible Materials, if any: NOTE: SPECIFY IF COLLECTING CANNOT BE DONE</b>	Smoky quartz, microcline, zircons and possibly Riebeckite, and astrophylite and other rare minerals.
<b>Est. Time of Return to Original Meeting Place:</b>	We will meet at a designated location or at the entrance gate at 4:30 PM. Be there or you will be locked in!
<b>Vehicle Requirements, if any:</b>	Four wheel drive high clearance vehicles required.
<b>Physical Limitation Concerns, Including Accessibility to Handicapped Individuals:</b>	The trip it is at a higher altitude than Colorado Springs (approx. 8,000 feet) so those who have a difficulty with altitude should not participate. Not recommended for those who have difficulty in walking on uneven terrain.
<b>Equipment or Tools Recommended or Required:</b>	A small pick and shovel, an old paint brush, an old screw driver, a rock hammer, safety glasses, and some sort of bucket or pack for carrying any specimens found. Also desirable are some paper for wrapping specimens.
<b>Availability of Water and Sanitary Facilities:</b>	There are no facilities available. Bring water, snack and a lunch.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	The weather can change between morning and afternoon at this altitude and this time of the year. Wear appropriate clothing (layered) and hiking boots. Sunscreen is recommended. <b>It is important that you arrive on time and you follow the schedule. Once in the closed area of Gold Camp Road you will be locked in and if you miss the group departure you will not be able to get your vehicle out!
